## ATP joins forces with Web Manuals



Aircraft Technical Publishers (ATP) has teamed up with Web Manuals to enable its customers to more efficiently digitise and streamline the management of their operating manuals.

Under the new partnership, announced today at the show, ATP will begin offering Web Manuals' functionality through its ATP Aviation Hub cloud application.
